



## **IMPORT OF PLANTS AND OTHER MATERIALS**

For the import of plants for the WOC22, the following requirements must be met:

1.- Obtaining a Phytosanitary Import Permit

A) Send to LINAMAR (Bonded Agent of Customs) with a copy to Marcelo Bejarano, at least 60 days in advance the list of genera of plants to be imported including the approximate gross weight in kg (Invoice or Proforma Invoice)

B) Inform route of the shipment

C) Upon receipt of the information, the Broker will proceed to obtain the phytosanitary import permit and send it to the person or company from abroad.

D) The cost of this procedure (fees) varies in the following range:

Import license (phytosanitary permit). \$ 80.00 plus VAT, (\$ 91.20)

Values for the payment of the license in Agrocalidad fluctuates from \$ 42.00 to \$ 80.00 per kilos of the merchandise.

Example: Up to 1000 Kilos is paid \$ 41.53

For each additional Kilo is paid \$ 0.01666

Example: 1200 Kg \$ 41.53 + 3.33 = \$ 44.85

## **2.- Documentation that must accompany the plants:**

A) CITES export permit from the country of origin

B) Phytosanitary permit of the country of origin indicating that the requirements of Ecuador have been fulfilled

C) Commercial invoice of all plants

D) Packing List

E) Phytosanitary import permit granted by Ecuadorian authorities

F) Plants must arrive at the root peeled and / or with moss spaghnum and free of insects or animals. Ecuadorian authorities will inspect the plants and will not allow entry if an insect or animal is found.

The amounts to be paid to the Broker for this process will be:

Broker \$ 187.50 plus VAT \$ 213.75

Payment of airway bill \$ 35 to \$ 54.00

Agrocalidad fee \$ 58.63 for Agrocalidad Inspection

Storage fee \$ 550.00 (approximately 380pounds)



**Example**

380 KG \$ 25 + 76 = approximately \$ 101.00 (ambient temperature)

380 KG \$ 25 + 76 +76 = approximately \$ 177.00 (Cold Chamber)

Attached is the tariff of the Air Cargo Terminal warehouse.

It is suggested as the plant is going to remove it the same day, which does not use cold camera

Note: All media goes with invoice

**EXPORT OF PLANTS AFTER WOC22**

1. Two documents are required to carry plants from Ecuador:

A) CITES permit granted by the Cites authority of Ecuador (Ministry of the Environment)

B) Phytosanitary permit granted by Agrocalidad (Ministry of Agriculture)

C) Only these permits will be granted to the plants purchased from authorized vendors for which the invoice given to the purchase of the plants must be presented. Permits may also be obtained for plants sold by foreign participants who have imported plants for the WOC22

D) These permits will be granted in the facilities of the Convention Center; at the sales area there will be two places to issue these permits.

E) These permits have a cost determined by the authorities of the Cites and Agrocalidad, and that will be informed in a timely manner.

F) There will be an additional cost if for the obtaining of these permits if the participation of the Broker is required.
